DOG UPDATES:

We are happy to report that during the months of February and March 2016, five of our heartworm positive dogs have completed their treatment and are now ready for adoption.

During February and March 2016, we took in 16 dogs and placed 13 in their new homes. Most are in NC, but three are in VA, one is in NJ, and one is in CT. It gives us great pleasure to share some of their stories with you.

Paisley

Paisley is a delightful 5 year old female we accepted on February 21, and on the day of intake Dr. Rita McGinnis found that Paisley's knees were in terrible shape. After examining her and getting her up to date on her vaccinations, she set up an evaluation by an orthopedic surgeon. We were fortunate that the specialist was able to see Paisley the same week. Unfortunately, the news was not good. Paisley was found to need Tibial Plateau Leveling Osteotomy (TPLO) on both knees, and the recommended protocol is to do them one at a time. After much soul searching about the cost of two such procedures, surgery on the first knee was done on 3/21. We are still holding a fund raiser to pay for both knees eventually. Even with only one new knee Paisley would be much better off than she had been. She spent the first two weeks following surgery at Dr. Rita's clinic because she needed extensive post op care but is now back with her foster family for her continued recovery – and to await her second surgery. Please see the attached photo of sweet Paisley 35 days after her surgery. Her wonderful foster parents arranged a spacious but relatively confined room for her so she would limit her activity.



Paisley always has to be taken out using the sling to support her rear. And her loving foster parents built the special ramp for her. Foster Dad added this: "I really didn't see myself getting back into a rescue situation quite like this one but Paisley is a joy to be around and has been SO good having to live in her confined space."

Hunter

Hunter came to us in January 2015, and after over a year boarding and in foster care, Hunter finally went to his new home in Virginia. Hunter had a couple of near adoptions but he knew best – he was waiting for the perfect family for him! He was right, and he now has that home. And the feeling is obviously mutual as evidenced by their words:

"Hunter has filled a huge void in my husband's and my life we were not totally aware of. He fits in wonderfully. Our 3 sons come by to see him almost daily. He plays with the




cat, our other dog, and the grandchildren. His nickname is Goofy because of his antics. He loves our granddaughters dearly. He goes to the window and watches for the school bus every afternoon. They come home and greet him before anyone else and have a game. I am so thankful to you and Hunter. He is truly special."


Huck

Huck was originally from Alabama and had spent his entire 10 years living outside in a chain link fence. (Please see the Kathy L.'s President's Letter from the January issue for great teamwork from our sister rescues in Georgia and South Caroling in getting him surrendered, transported, vetted, and delivered to Kathy in NC.)

Huck now lives in Virginia with his Dad and new best friend, a 14 year old 85% deaf Ori-Pei named Rambo. Huck's Dad shared what their first month was like for them.

"Huck and I take at least 1 walk a day. We have gone to 9 different trails/parks. Huck has told me which ones he likes the best. I was surprised at how well he fetches. He races to pick up the stick/toy and brings it right back to me...Another thing I'm pleasantly surprised at is that Huck responds to my whistle. As soon as I whistle he comes right to me.





The second time lasted about an hour. This time he tore up a 4" by 5" corner of a plywood floor board. Okay--I got the message. Henceforth, I left him alone in the house with Rambo. All went well. He would go upstairs to the bed room to nap on his pillow. So I got him a new Costco dog bed and placed it on the ground floor. Now he naps on that when I'm gone for short periods.

I had Huck for 10 days before I heard him bark...A big Brown UPS truck pulled in next store and Huck went 'crazy' barking at it. He hasn't barked again in 3 weeks. Huck does not like UPS brown trucks---I think there is a little history there.

I took Huck with me to Western New York, near Lake Erie, this past week...he rides great in cars. He's very reserved/shy toward other dogs. I've exposed him to a lot of first-time doggy meetings---and he has done great.

Huck has been a true gentleman. He has brought me great joy. His personality has really started to show. When he gently places his huge paw on my leg and puts his head in my lap, it makes you almost melt.

Huck is a great addition to my life. In only a month, I find myself quite attached to him. I thank you for all the work your organization has done so that I can enjoy the fruits of your labor and the joy Huck brings to me."



Milla

Milla came to us from a shelter in NC – a very tall, gangly Weim with a full tail. Her foster family fell in love with her, and ended up adopting her within two weeks of bringing her home with them. Milla's 14 year old human "sister" gave her a new nickname, Lady Milla Vanilla, and described their family's transition from foster to adopter.



"When we first met Milla, she was very shy and not very comfortable with us. But when we took her home, after a few minutes of exploring, she made herself right at home. She jumped up on the couch and ran around, all the while her tongue hanging out. You could see the joy all over her face. Within the first week, we knew that she was the dog we had been looking for. Although it still takes her a few minutes to warm up to new things, she has learned to love new people and meeting new dogs at doggie daycare. She's happy, and playful, and she loves to be around her family. She is exactly what our family needed, and I look forward to spending many years with her."

AnnaLea

AnnaLea joined us from an owner that had inherited her from a family member. She had heartworms, and the new owner treated her heartworm infection, got her healthy, and then contacted TWR to surrender her in order for her to find a perfect home. Sweet AnnaLea was adopted once but returned when she didn't work out with that family, but she finally found the perfect home this year. AnnaLea's new Mom shares her story with us below.

"It's never easy to lose a dog. Especially one that had been by your side for 13 years. One that had traveled all over the US with you and loved you unconditionally. But in September 2015, I lost my best friend, a Weimaraner named Cheyenne. Heartbroken, I wasn't sure if I would ever own another dog. Fast forward to December and with my heart on the mend, I contacted Tarheel Weimaraner Rescue. After I submitted my application, I waited patiently and then around Christmas I got a call. 'We have a little girl who might just be a good fit for you. Her name is



Jenna, but she seems to be shy and will need some structure'. Could this be it? Was I ready to open my heart and home to another dog?

At the beginning of the year I decided to have a meet and greet with Jenna. As I walked up the path at the dog park, I saw her. Full of spunk and just as petite as my Cheyenne girl. Instantly, my heart melted. That meeting turned into an overnight stay, then a trial period, and on January 17th, Jenna joined the family and started her new life as AnnaLea. Once again, my heart was complete.

In just a few short months AnnaLea has blossomed into an amazing companion, friend, and to my surprise, a hunting partner. On a quail hunting expedition, after a little coaching, it is like something clicked for AnnaLea. She began pointing and holding on quail, tapping into her instinct, like she had done it all her life. What a sight to see! We are working with her, channeling her energy and drive and along with her Boykin Spaniel sister Ellie, we plan to spend many hours this fall chasing birds on the wing.

Thank you to the Tarheel Weimaraner Rescue for bringing AnnaLea into my life. She has truly taught me that no one's heart is ever closed after you lose a dog...it actually expands more to embrace a new best friend."

Sophie

Sophie first came to us a year ago as an owner-surrender, and that was at least her third known home. She was adopted twice and returned through no fault of her own but due to adopters' health issues. Happily Sophie is now in her forever home with her new Dad and Weim brother Cooper. Sophie and her new family are thrilled with each other.

"After fostering my nephew's dog while he was away in the Army; my Weimaraner, Cooper, was missing his buddy when my nephew returned home. I knew we had the means and the capacity to love another dog, so I started searching and stumbled upon the Tarheel Weimaraner Rescue via google search. I viewed the site and started reading some profiles of the possible candidates ready for adoption. I submitted my application...and was contacted by my Placement Officer to review my application and discuss my desires for a female companion for Cooper. Originally, I was wanting a younger female so I could stagger the ages...I was being patient and waiting. I also considered fostering until we found the match...In the meantime, the picture of Sophie just kept tugging at



my heart...I couldn't get Sophie out of my mind...Her foster Mom contacted me...and provided all the details about Sophie and she just seemed perfect. We discussed the logistics and she indicated that she and her husband would make the 3 hour trip to my home for the meeting...I knew that Sophie was in really great hands for them to be willing to make the trip and ensure she would be placed in a loving environment. On Sun 2/21, we had our meet & greet and Sophie and Cooper immediately started playing and she warmed up to me immediately and it was a match. That afternoon, all the neighbors came to meet Sophie and she received a warm welcome from everyone. I had prepared myself for an adjustment period; however, everything simply fell right in place without effort. Sophie settled in so nicely and Cooper and I completely adore Sophie and we are thrilled to be her 'FOREVER HOME'. I'm baffled that she was rehomed a couple of times; however, I'm glad that path brought her to us. All of my family and friends are completely smitten with Sophie and agree it was just meant for her to be with us...I have enjoyed all the interactions from each person associated with TWR and this was a wonderful experience."

Maribelle

Maribelle has been mentioned in several previous newsletters from the time we got her from a shelter with a dreadful skin condition in early 2015. Since her recovery and adoption, we have given periodic updates on her and her progress toward becoming a Therapy Dog. We are pleased to announce that she just graduated from her Calm Dog class, and next is her CGC class. This will be her final preparations for becoming a Therapy Dog. We are so proud of Maribelle, and wish her and her Mom the best as they move toward their goal!

Dexter

Dexter, the 132 pound Weim, was profiled in the September 2015 newsletter. With his gradual and safe weight loss program he is down to 90 pounds. His vet doesn't expect him to lose much more because he is such a large boy. Happily, with his health and strength returned, his Dad reports that Dexter recently ran his first 10K. "We're very happy we get to share our home with him."

Axel

Axel is an owner-surrender from TN was adopted last year. He continues to do well in his new home, and recently graduated from Basic Dog Obedience. Axel also has a new TWR brother, Felix, and both boys are having a great time. Hopefully we'll hear from them again soon.
